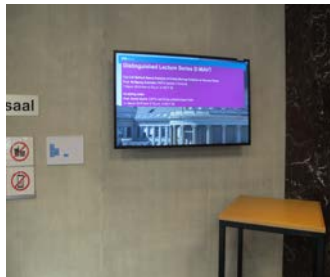
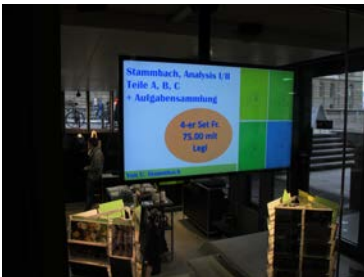
ETH Zurich, the Swiss Federal Institute of Technology, one of the leading international universities for technology and the natural sciences is using 75 BrightSign XD players to drive a campus-wide digital signage network, 25 to deliver video and IPTV services to its lecture theatres and 20 to display the menu in the new student restaurant.

ETHZ has licensed BrightSign Network Enterprise Edition. Content is stored on the University's own servers and managed by Communication Officers in each department.

Lectures taking place in one theatre can be streamed live, allowing the University to scale capacity easily for popular events and lectures. They can also be used to play back video content during lectures and deliver IPTV multicast.

The network was designed and installed by Armin Brunner, Head of Multimedia Services at ETHZ supported by Daniel Regli of BrightSign's Swiss distributor, Media Solutions. It replaces an existing network of Windows based players.

Armin Brunner is enthusiastic about the stability and ease of use of the BrightSign players. He said, "BrightSign is really perfect – we have never had any problem with stability with these players. You can switch the power off and on at any time without risk of corrupting the Hard Disk Drive."
